

## **2011 MWEDT RULES & Information**

1. Rider entry fees:

Knobby Novice / 90 Stock Novice	\$20
Amateur/Youth	\$30
Pro-Am	\$50
Pro	\$75
Gate Fee	\$10
(children 4 and under free)	
2. It is the duty and responsibility of the rider to determine the class in which he or she belongs. MWEDT officials may move riders up based on written or published proof that the rider has competed in a higher class. MWEDT officials will not move someone up just because they are fast. You must have proof that a rider rode in a higher class.
3. Riders must ride the same quad in the main event as was ridden in the heat race. If a different quad is ridden in the main event than was ridden in the heats, the rider must start from the penalty line as designated by a race official.
4. A rider must be on the starting line and complete one lap under their own power in the main event before being scored for the day.
5. MWEDT officials are not responsible for locating riders before their event.
6. If a rider leaves the course for ANY reason they must reenter the track at the safest possible point nearest the point of exit – but not at a point where they improve their position. Race officials will determine cutting the course, going around obstacles, etc. This infraction will be judged on a case by case basis.
7. If a race must be stopped because of a rider or riders obstructing the progress and safety of the race that rider or riders may not be allowed to restart the race unless allowed by the race official.
8. There will be NO restarts once one lap of the event has been completed, unless in the opinion of the race official continuing the race will endanger the riders.
9. If for any reason the race must be stopped it will be considered complete if the leading rider has completed over 50% of the laps. If a race event must be stopped due to weather, final race results will be set according to finish position in the Heat race.
10. Lapped riders must move over or be black flagged. If a black flag has been given to a rider and that rider fails or refuses to move over, the rider will be disqualified and score no points for the event.
11. DNS means DID NOT START. A rider not coming to the line and completing one full lap will receive a DNS. A rider receiving a DNS in the main event will not receive race points for the event.
12. DNF means DID NOT FINISH. Riders will receive a DNF if they complete one or more laps of the main event but do not take the checkered flag. A rider who DNF's will receive last place points in the main event.
13. Age as of January 1, 2011 determines which age group you ride.
14. Yellow Flag Situation: NO PASSING / NO IMPROVING OF POSITION in the yellow flag area. Penalty is a minimum of one finishing position per infraction. This will be a decision of the race official.
15. The White Flag is a courtesy flag. It is not necessary to display the white flag at the beginning of the final lap.
16. Any verbal harassment or physical abuse of MWEDT officials will be grounds for permanent disqualification.
17. No alcoholic beverages or beverages or illegal substances will be allowed on the track or the staging area. Riders should not use any of the above mentioned substances before or during an event as long as they remain in

competition. Any rider that is impaired will not be allowed to compete and may be subject to permanent disqualification.

18. A rider is responsible for the actions of their Pit Crew. Infractions by riders Pit Crew or associated spectators will be grounds for penalties against their rider. Fighting by a rider or a member of his/her pit crew and associated spectators will be grounds for disqualification.
19. All riders will be given a front row start in heat races.
20. All races will be started in one of the following ways:
  - A. With a light: light will be red and go directly from red to green.
  - B. With a flag: starter will hold flag on the ground and riders may go on first movement.
21. Season-end points for Amateur and Pro Am classes will be based on the top finish of each rider in 6 of the 7 scheduled series events. In the determination of season-end points, a throwout race CAN BE a race that the rider did not attend. However, ten (10) season-end bonus points will be awarded to riders that attend all scheduled and non-cancelled MWEDT series events. **The Pro Class will not have a throwout race, and bonus points do not apply.**
22. In the event that a regularly scheduled series event is canceled due to uncontrollable circumstances, the event will attempt to be rescheduled one time. If the event cannot be rescheduled, or the rescheduled event is canceled, the event will not be rescheduled and the Series will become a shortened series for the year. End-of-season points will be adjusted accordingly to account for one throwout race as stated above.
23. Awards will be given out at each event to the top 1/3 of each class for Amateur, Youth, and Novice. Pro-Am will be 80% payback of entry for the class. Pro will be 100% payback of entry for the class. Pro and Pro-Am payback will be top 1/3 of class.
24. Laps will be as follows:

Amateur / Youth	6 lap heats / 10 lap mains
Pro Am	6 lap heats / 12 lap mains
Pro	6 lap heats / 15 lap mains
24. Each rider must be a member of the MWEDT (\$20) to be eligible for end-of-year awards. If an end-of-season awards banquet is scheduled, awards will be given at the banquet. If a banquet is not scheduled, awards will be mailed to riders.
25. The races will not be ATVA/AMA sanctioned, but their rules will be followed unless otherwise noted.
26. All tracks will use the MWEDT race order at all events.
